

With the mission to enhance the living quality of the elderly in the community through the use of technology and people-oriented services, Senior Citizen Home Safety Association (SCHSA, 長者安居協會) continues to enhance our services by extending home-based 『平安鐘®』 service to outdoor assistance services, including services that are specially designed for elders with dementia. Officially opened in September 2013, SCHSA Jockey Club Oi Man Centre has become the heart and soul of the meaningful services of Personal Emergency Link (平安鐘), Safety Phone (平安手機), Mobile Link (隨身寶), eCare Link (智平安) for the senior citizens in Hong Kong. It is also a place where we advocate Active Ageing, and where we engage generations of people to learn and understand ageing from different perspective, so as to build empathy and the sense of responsibility to care about old people. SCHSA is no longer the ‘invisible’ caring team behind the phone line. As an important milestone of SCHSA’s advocacy to change the negative perception of old age amongst the younger generations, we established Asia’s first interactive experience centre with the theme of ‘life journey’. Since its opening, Life Journey Centre has received thousands of local and overseas visitors from schools and universities, NGOs, and government bodies.

Recently, SCHSA collaborates with HKT, our technology partner to provide preventive health monitoring and nursing hotline service as a pilot project for tele-healthcare service. At present, personal health devices supported by the service includes blood glucose and blood pressure monitors. In addition to measuring and storing health data via eSmartHealth’s cloud-based solution platform, nurses at SCHSA Call & Care Centre will make caring calls to service users in case the health data is out of range. We are also conducting a pilot program at South Kwai Chung Service Centre, where the service is provided to a group of elders in the neighbourhood and the pilot users will attend measurements regularly at the centre.

As the world evolves, technology advances and life-style changes, there are so much more that Hong Kong, as a smart city, could do to better serve the health care needs of the citizens, especially our seniors.

I was an electronics enthusiast who built crystal radio in form one and single board computers Motorola D1 and D2 kits in 1977 and expanded them into a full computer with 24 KB RAM and a terminal kit with a keyboard and a BW TV as monitor. I was aware that computers would be an indispensable tool in education, so I founded the Microcomputer Group at the Hong Kong Professional Teachers' Union in 1979 and was a co-founder of the Hong Kong Association for Computer Education (HKACE) in 1981. I organised the first Computer Conference and Exhibition for School Teachers and Principals in 1982 at Queen's College and later the Microcomputers in Education Conference, Exhibition and Competition 1984 to 1987 (MIE84-87) to promote computer education when I was a secondary school teacher, and the Information Technology in Education Conference, Exhibition and Competition 1998 and 1999 (ITE98, ITE99) to promote IT Education when I served as Senior Lecturer of the Department of Information & Applied Technology of the Hong Kong Institute of Education. I taught computer languages and software packages.

Now I am serving the Employees' Retraining Board as Technical Advisor (IT) and Teaching Advisor. After my liver transplant in 2008 I began to serve at patients' organisations and later the eHealth Consortium. As I am a beneficiary and stakeholder of the Electronic Health Record System and organ transplantation, it is my interest to promote the system, organ donation and sports for transplant athletes, and to serve various committees in the Hospital Authority and hospitals.

After being a board member of the eHealth Consortium for four years, I found board members worked closely and eagerly together to promote eHealth by organising and supporting seminars and conferences for medical and technological areas. By attending these seminars and conferences, I have met many knowledgeable people and learnt a lot of new things from them. 

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
